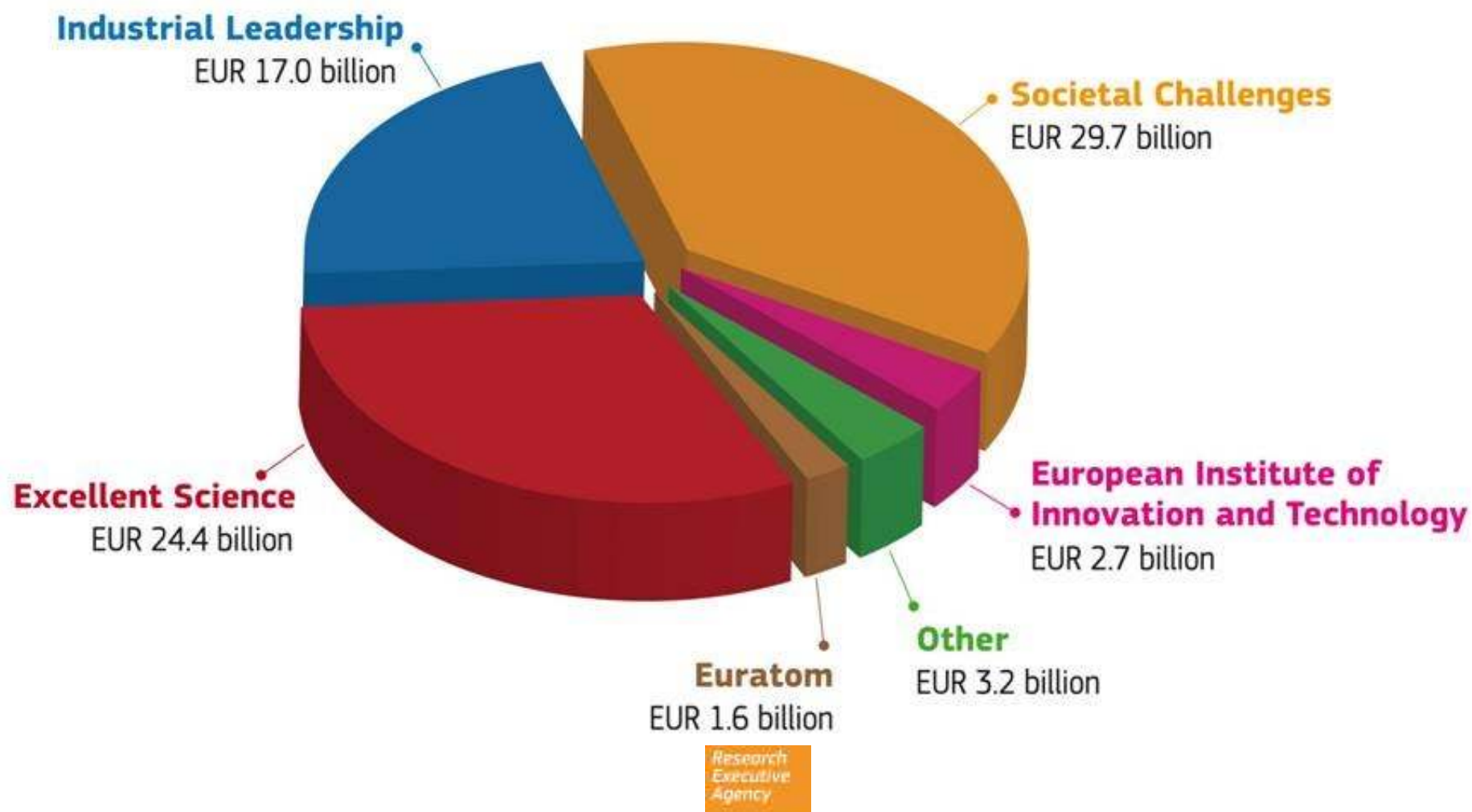

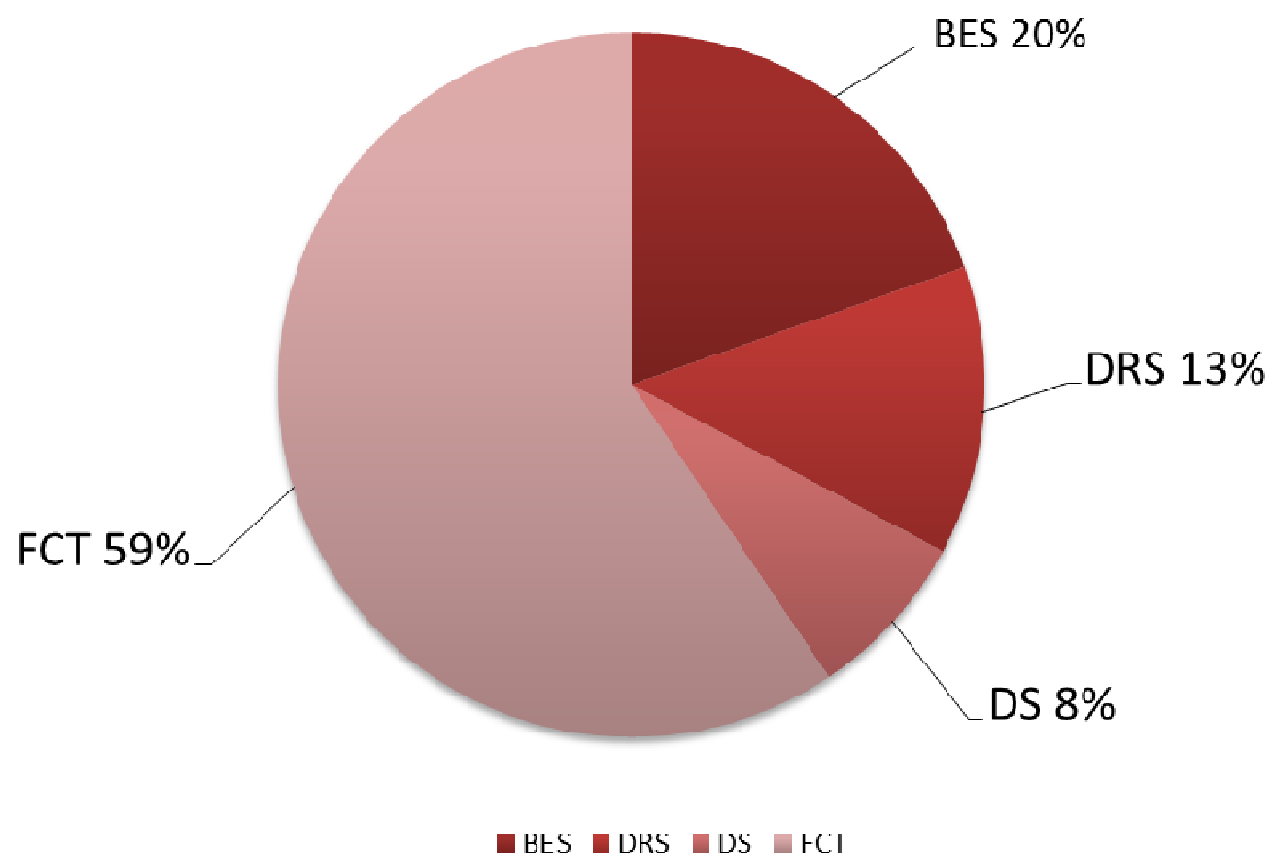

Four calls:

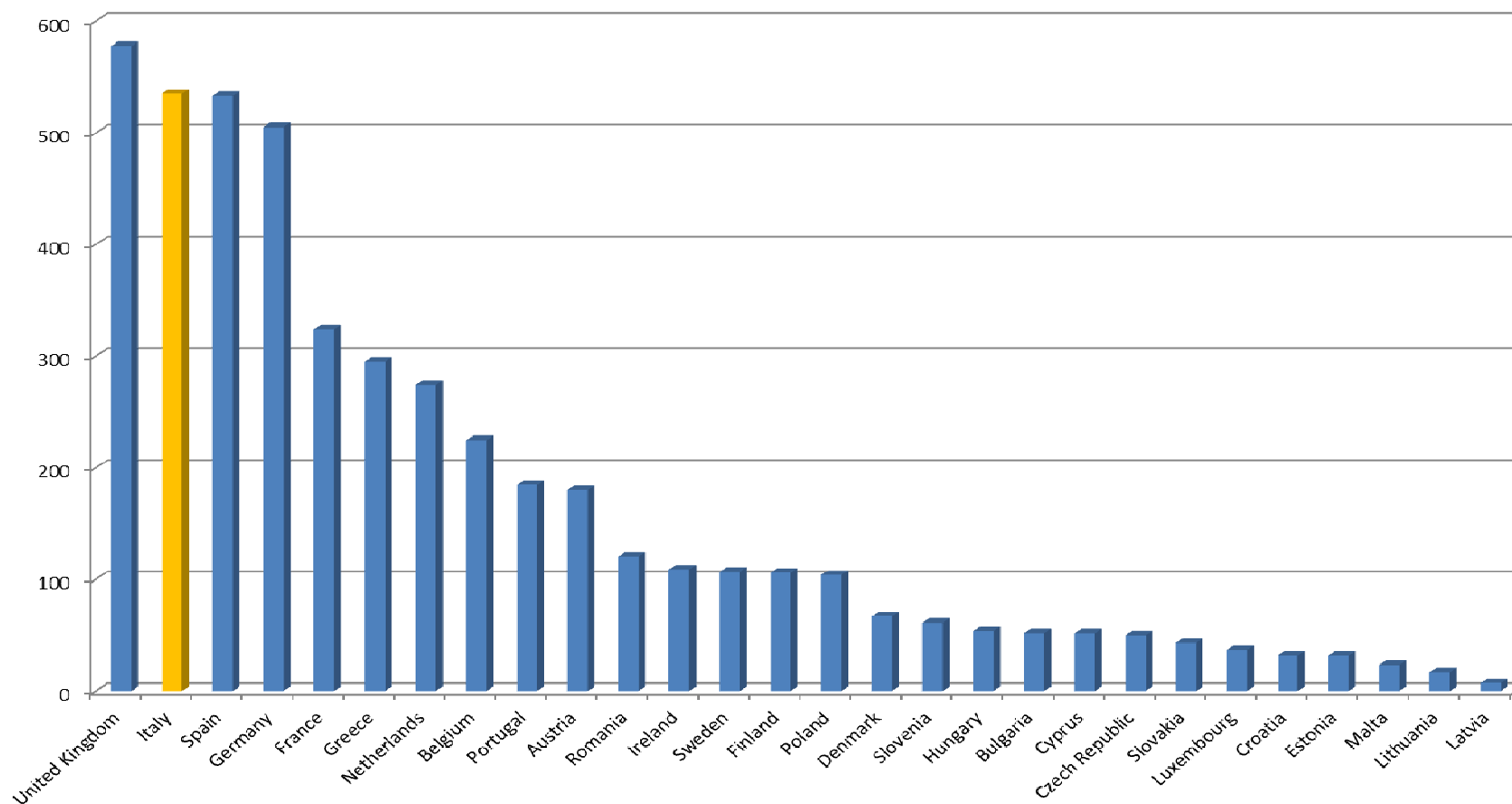
- **DRS** – Disaster-resilience: safeguarding and securing society, including adapting to climate change

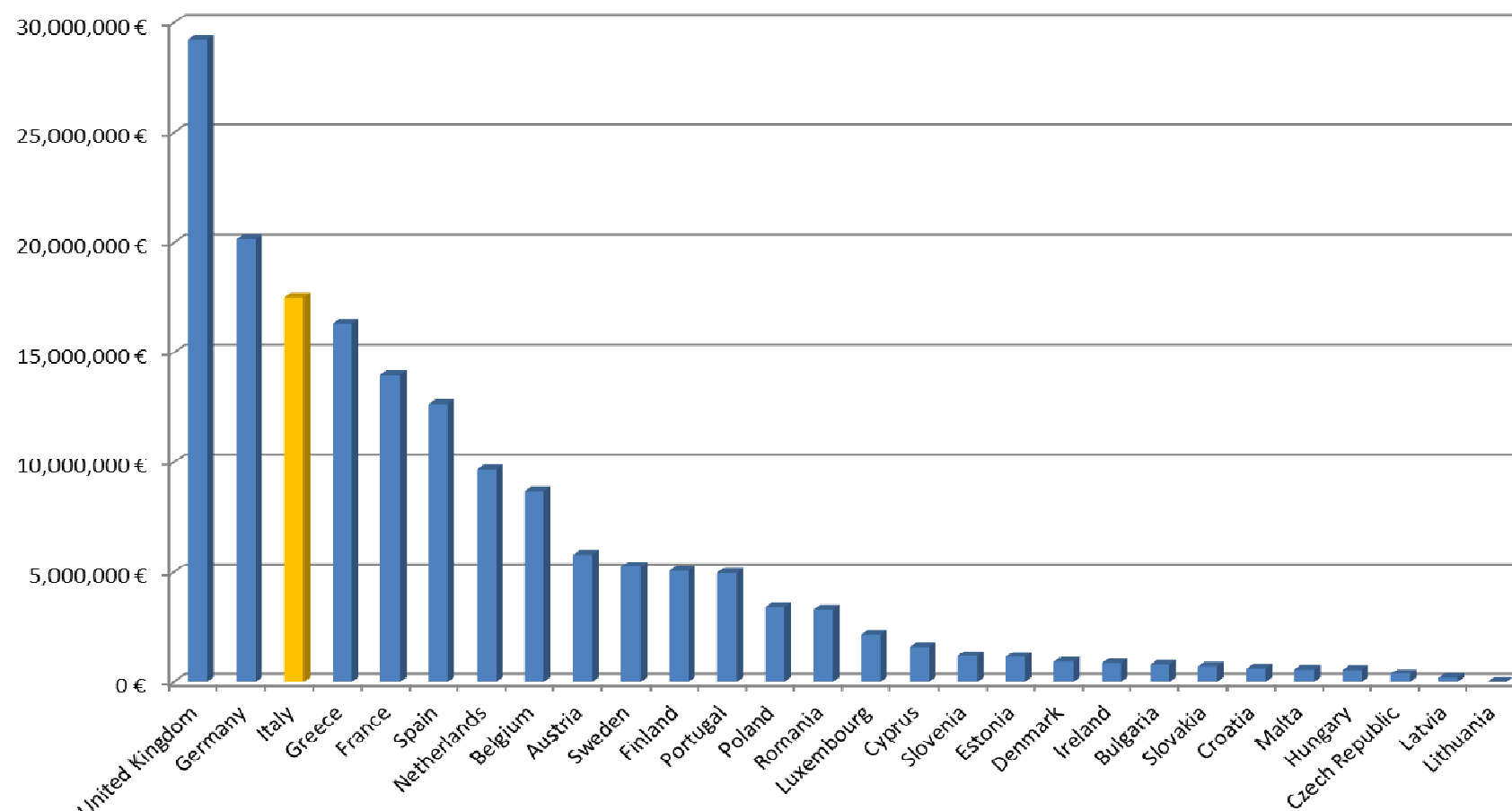
Participation of EU MSs H2020 Security Call 2014

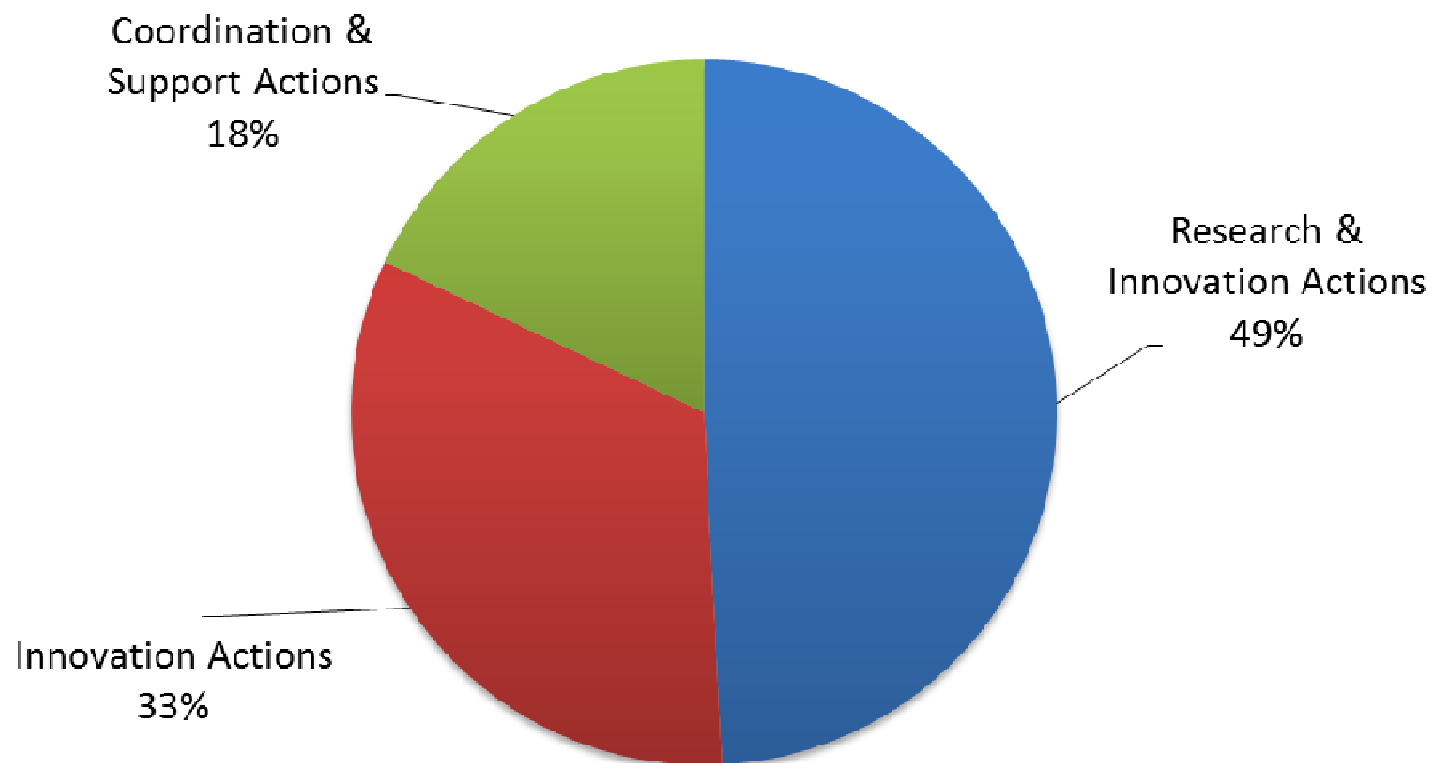
Funds Distribution per EU MS H2020 Security Call 2014

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Distribution of Funds per Action Italy 2014

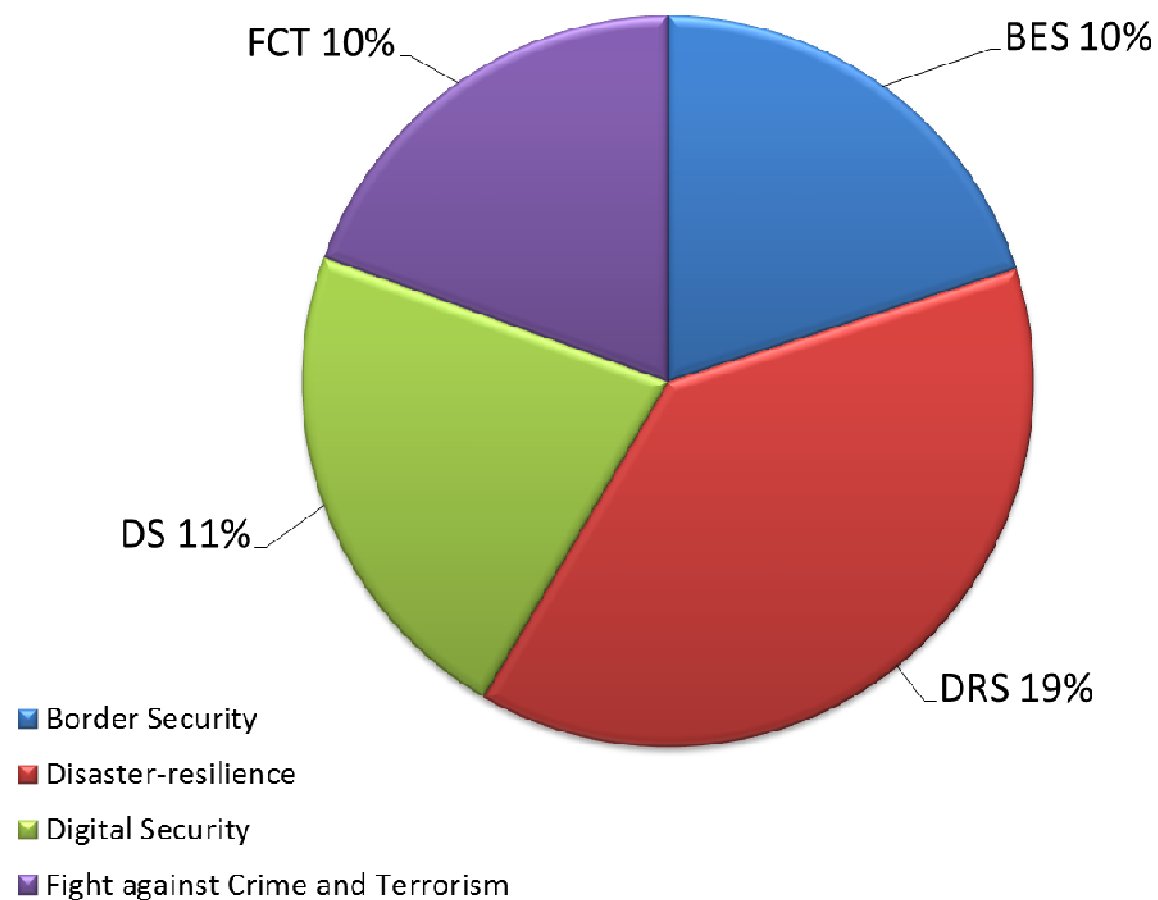

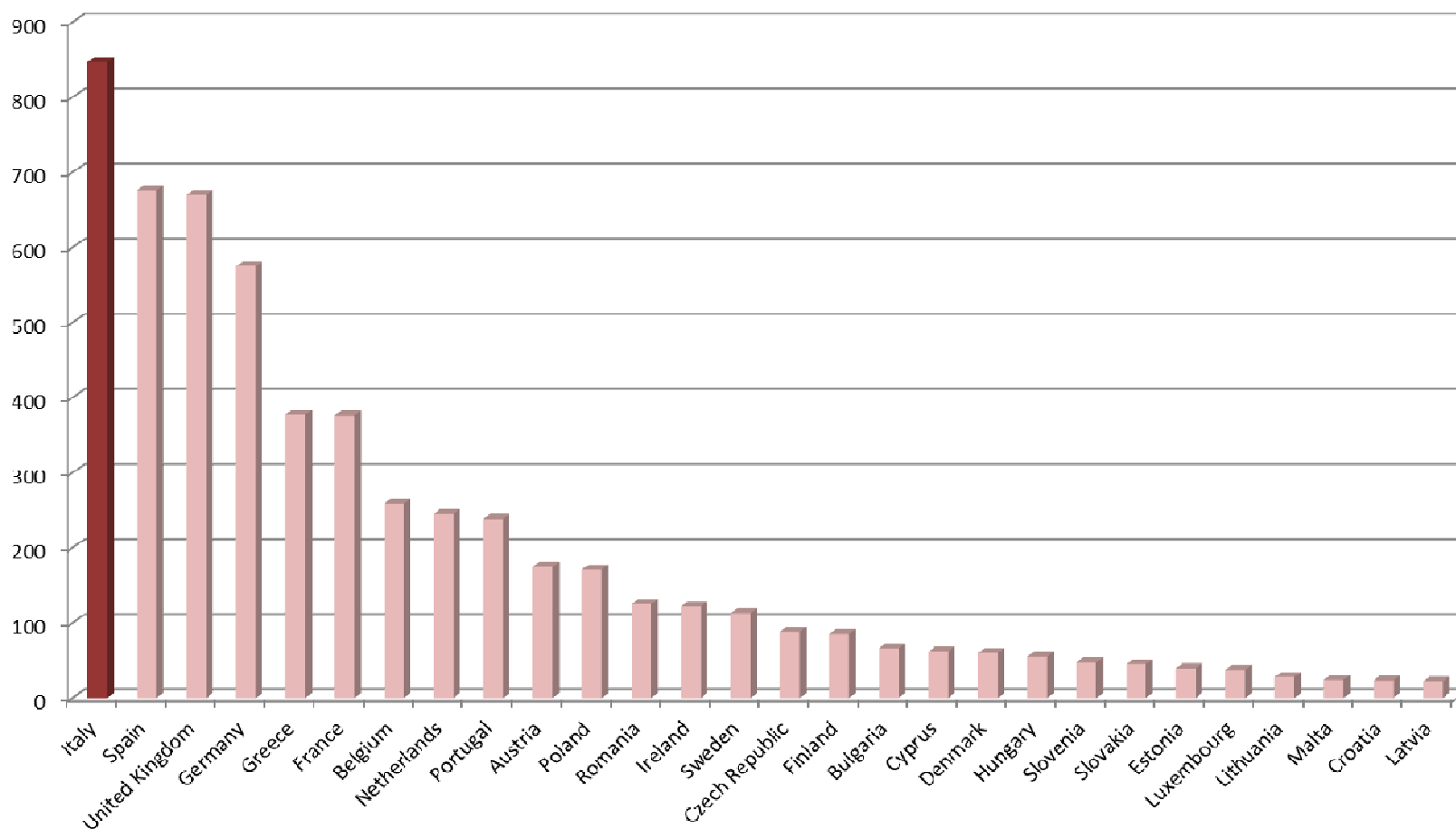

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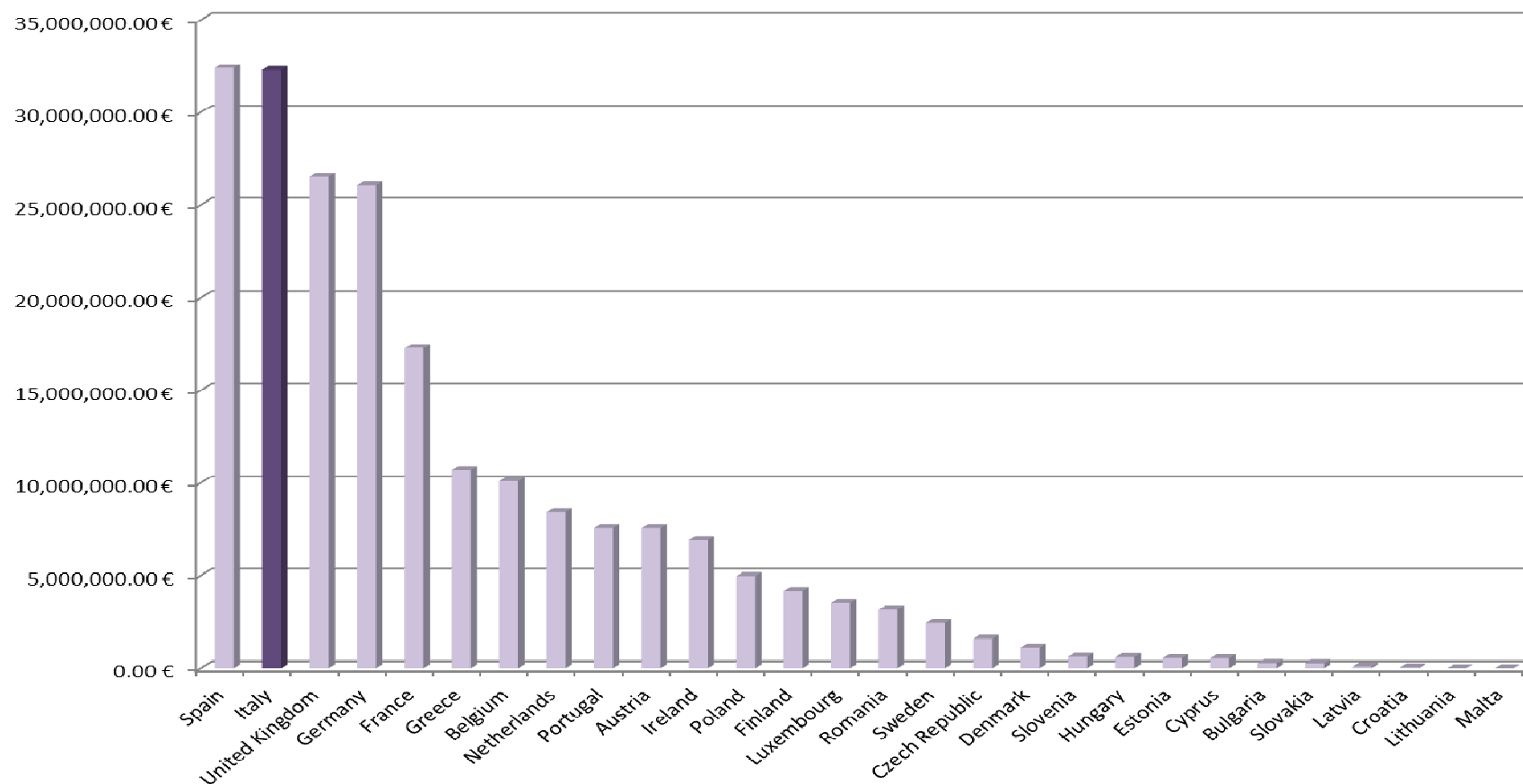
Participation of EU MSs H2020 Security Call 2015

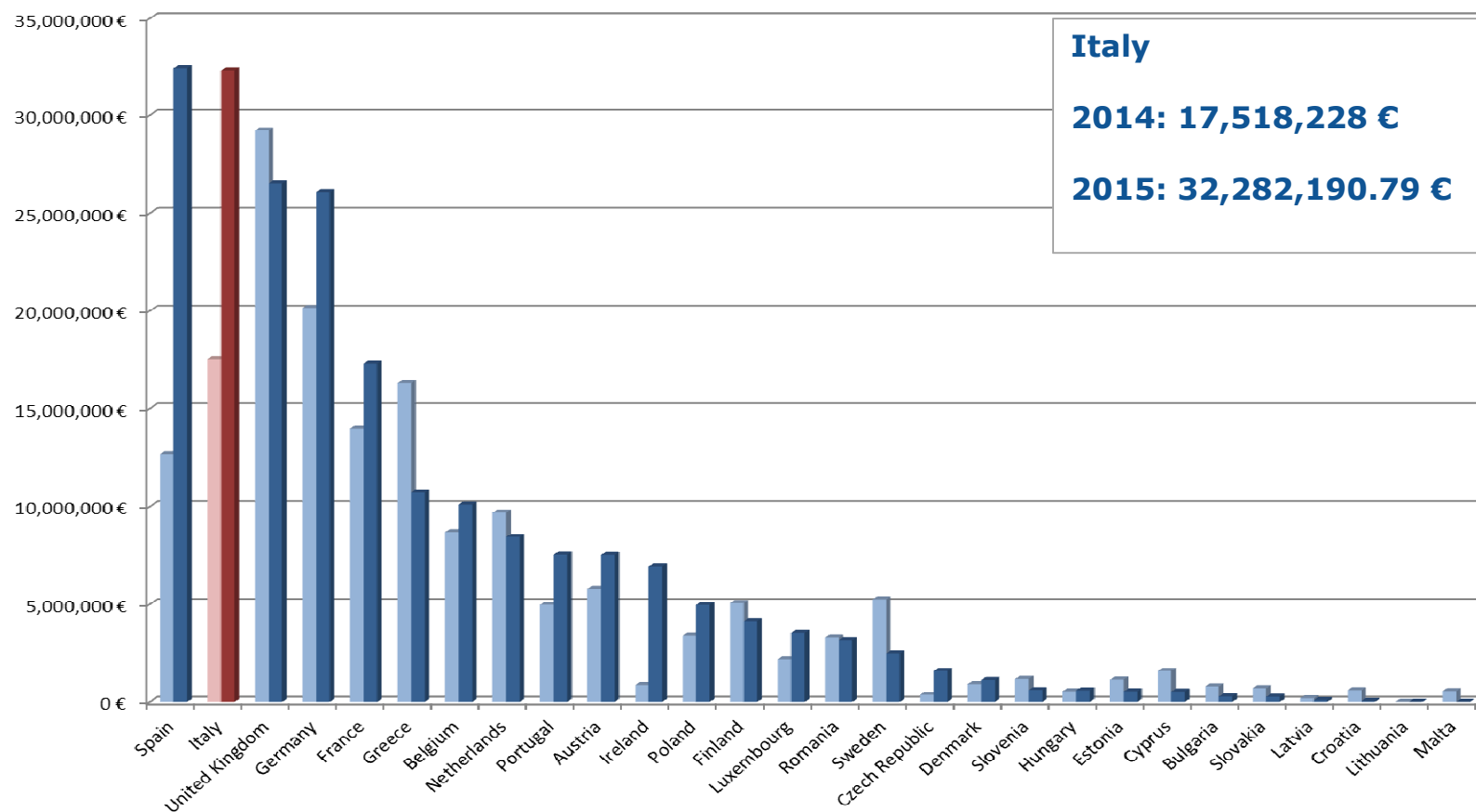
Funds Distribution per EU MS H2020 Security Call 2015

- Build on steps already taken to **involve practitioners**
- Encourage and support a **network of security practitioners** and first responders
- Design Calls to **adapt research priorities** to changing circumstances
- Reduce barriers to **cross-border cooperation** – of Member States, industry and practitioners
- Expand **collaboration** between **public and private** sectors



H2020 Work Programme 2018-2020

Strategic orientations

Five key focus domains have been identified for the forthcoming funding periods:

- Borders and External security
- Fighting Crime and Counter-terrorism
- Secure and Resilient Societies
- Cybersecurity and Digital Privacy
- Competitive European Security Industry



Focus Area

"Supporting the Security Union"

A central aim of the Focus Area will be to support the implementation of the Security Union, reflecting the priorities set out by the Commission. The goal will be to deliver concrete solutions for security practitioners in the EU, while at the same time supporting the implementation of the EU policies related to security.



Envisaged principles of the Focus Area

- *Coordinated approach on topic prioritisation (Security Union Task Force)*
- *Common criteria on practitioner participation*
- *Security scrutiny to be applied across the calls*
- *Coordinated call deadlines*
- *Partially shared experts*
